- Create a variety of original materials/curriculum to educate and disseminate transportation related information to target populations and raise awareness of the Mobility Management project.
- Plan and conduct outreach events to target populations in the Bridgeport/Stamford Urbanized Zone.
- Maintain required written records and reports in compliance with agency and funding source requirements.
- Research all available transportation resources (public and private that could be utilized by people with disabilities and/or senior citizens residing and/or working in the greater Bridgeport/Stamford area and compile these resources into an accessible guide available in print and electronically.
- Plan and execute outreach and other public events to educate the target populations re:available transportation resources.
- Utilize surveys, focus groups, social media, other internet based methods (in addition to in-person visits) to gather information on gaps in existing transportation resources in the target region.
